

#### We will be marking the **Week of Prayer for Christian Unity** here in Winnipeg from January 18-25, 2025.

"The resources for 2025 have been prepared by the community of Bose, an ecumenical monastery of brothers and sisters in northern Italy, and by the international Week of Prayer for Christian Unity Writing Team. The theme chosen is "*Do you believe this*?" (John 11:26). 2025 marks the 1,700<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first Christian Ecumenical Council, held in Nicaea, near Constantinople in 325 AD. This commemoration provides a unique opportunity to reflect on and celebrate the common faith of Christians, as expressed in the Creed formulated during this Council, a faith that remains alive and fruitful in our time. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2025 offers an invitation to draw on this shared heritage and to enter more deeply into the faith that unites all Christians.

With the 2025 Week of Prayer for Christians, we are pleased to announce that we have managed to organize several days of events to mark the WPCU here in Winnipeg beginning with a City-wide Ecumenical Worship Service to be held at <u>7:30 pm on Sunday evening</u>, January 19, 2025, at Holy Family Ukrainian Catholic Church, 1001 Grant Avenue, Winnipeg.

We cordially invite church leaders (i.e. bishops, moderators, presbytery chairs, pastors, etc. and/or their representatives) to take an active part leading the worship during the upcoming City-wide Ecumenical Worship Service on January 19th." The Committee
