We were shocked at the amount of our last rectory water bill. Normally it is about \$100. Our last bill was over \$1,800!! It was determined that the toilet downstairs had been running continuously from December 2<sup>nd</sup> to December 15<sup>th</sup> then (miraculously) stopped, but then started again on January 21<sup>st</sup> until it was noticed on January 27<sup>th</sup>. Proper protocol is that the last person out does a walk around to check on things, especially taps and toilets. Please be sure to fulfill these duties as we can ill afford another extremely high utility bill.
