All Souls' Day November 2nd

This year, All Souls' Day will begin with blessings and candle lighting in **St. François Xavier at 2:00 p.m.** and then in **St. Eustache at 4:00 p.m.** We will continue the commemoration with Mass at **Blessed Sacrament Church in Elie at 5:00 p.m.** followed by a procession to the **Elie cemetery at 5:30 p.m.**

Candles will be sold for \$5 for your loved ones for placing in the cemetery. The parish council and liturgy will distribute them accordingly. We will also be collecting names and monies on Sundays after church. *(To assist us in the placing of candles, please indicate at which cemetery your loved ones are buried.)*
