- Reading Summaries for Epiphany -

First Reading: Isaiah 60:1-6

The last part of the book of Isaiah contains the words of a prophet who lived after the Jews returned from exile in Babylon which is modern-day Iraq. They found their temple destroyed and the city leveled. But with great faith the prophet envisions a wonderful future for Jerusalem.

Second Reading: Ephesians 3:2-3, 5-6

The Ephesians were a community in which Jewish and Gentile converts lived side-by-side. The author of this letter confirms that God's saving grace is available to everyone, whatever their ethnic or religious background.
