

**- Reading Summaries for Holy Family Sunday -**

**First Reading: Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14**

The book of Sirach was written by a wise teacher who lived 200 years before Christ. Sirach ran a school for young people in Jerusalem. In today's section, he advises his students on the proper way to honour their parents.

**Second Reading: Colossians 3:12-17**

The letter to the Colossians was written around the year 80 A.D. A significant concern in this letter is how the Christian community appears to outsiders. The author offers guidelines so that Christian families will live in such a way that others will notice the difference.
